Extended abstracts will only be published in the abstract book and will be included in the poster sessions. Full papers could be presented in oral sessions or poster sessions and depending on their quality, will also be published in the conference proceedings, selected journals or as book chapters.

All submissions will be double blind and peer reviewed and evaluated based on originality, technical and/or research content/depth, correctness, relevance to the conference, contributions, and readability.

All submissions to the conference will be done electronically and the author and coauthors (if any) will be able to sign up for the on-line service. Documents submitted electronically must meet editorial requirements and limits specified in the Call for Papers.
